The Word of The Lord for 2020 and Beyond

Usually every year the Lord deals with me regarding the theme for the next year around October or November of the preceding year. I knew 2020 would be a different year because I had heard nothing from God in reference to a theme. Now when I theme a year, they are for the personal milestone, ministerial objectives, or spiritual milestones. So I accepted the Word my Pastor set as the theme for the local church, 2020 A Vision to build. I accepted this, as I felt as it was from God, Befitting, and clever. Also because I had heard no word from God concerning the new year except in December when he said "Sickness is coming!" Many Churches and Ministries adopted themes having to do with 2020 and Vision, and while many say we didn't see this coming, I say it is still prophetic. In order for blurry vision to become corrected, the individual must go through a painful, and frightening optical surgery. COVID-19 is our surgery, used by God to clear the vision of the Church and the World!

So when God said that June would be my month of confirmation, I had no clue that he would deal with me concerning these issues, or give me a theme for a year that is exactly halfway over!

The climate of the world moving forward will be as of the tale of two cities, "it was the best of times, it was the worst of times!"

So here is what the Lord has given me for the Church dealing with 2020 and beyond

- 1. This is a season for exposure, throughout every area of society.
- 2. There is a changing of the guards throughout every area of society
- 3. The Democratic Party will rise in power again, and a group of young and or unknown individuals will rise in power within both parties. Great divides will take place, but also alliances. There will be those with good hearts to rise in the GOP and will fight to unite the parties
- 4. God is neither a Republican or Democrat, which will be shown as both parties will be exposed for longstanding evil, causing many lifelong members to leave and form new confederations
- 5. Struggle over governmental & political power will continue in the US and worldwide
- 6. This is the time to consolidate and pay off debts, save money, and build credit. Property (land, buildings, and homes) will be released for free or next to nothing.
- 7. Prominent Churches will fall and merge with smaller churches under less popular leadership
- 8. Prepare yourself to witness splits in major black denominations and fellowships, Pray that God will bind the Spirits of Saul and Absalom.
- 9. Every Church must embrace multiculturalism or face the impending expiration date for their ministry.
- 10. Denominations will be inclusive or obsolete and unsuccessful with no spirit or spiritual power.
- 11. Men will return to the Church, but only to the Churches ready to teach, train, and disciple them.
- 12. The supernatural will return to the Church, & young people will be at the forefront of this move
- 13. Kingdom businesses and talents will boom in Ministry, Activism, Entertainment, and Government
- 14. Those with visions concerning Human, Civil, & Health Services, create your proposals now. For favor will hit it in this season, the money will be released from several areas including federal funding.
- 15. Pray for clear vision, guard your heart, and spiritual eyes.

- 16. Remove yourselves from unholy alliances and relationships.
- 17. Pray for the Mental health of Pastors, pray against mental breakdowns, Alzheimer's, etc.
- 18. Pray for Christians especially Missionaries in foreign lands, that they won't be caught in the crossfires of political struggles. Pray for their peace, protection, and needs to be met.
- 19. A new religion will rise, appearing as Christianity but embracing witchcraft & astrology as practices
- 20. Pray against satanic gateways through TV, Movies, music & viral challenges. Darkness will try to corrupt young people through lies, suicide, and depressions
- 21. Stay saved, live holy, and tithe to be eligible for protection and blessing. Get under your spiritual covering and be obedient!
- 22. The LGBT community agenda will rise in power & popularity but will face setbacks in laws and legislation. And though against the word fo God, DO NOT HATE those belonging to the LGBT community, they are apart of our harvest. Preach against sin with Love and don't use derogatory terms. Pastors clean your lives and churches or prepare to be a laughingstock. Be ready to give an account and use Bible-based theology and you will see deliverance take place in gay, lesbian, and transgender people.
- 23. Pray against the onset of new neurological disorders
- 24. It's time to become healthier and take homeopathic approaches to medicine & healthcare
- 25. A new medicine will rise as a popular cure-all to an existing disease but will kill many and negatively affect a large number of people. Be prayerful before taking any new medications.
- 26. Pray against inclement and disastrous weather.
- 27. Human trafficking will rise to alarming rates, especially with young women of color. Pray against human, drug, and sex trade. Pray for exposure to pedophilia rings and abuse of children. Through prayer, cold cases will find new evidence and concrete conclusion, and lives will be saved.
- 28. Black culture will shift by accepting more androgenous looks, behaviors, and fashions.
- 29. Pray against the mutations of COVID-19
- 30. Do not curse the remainder of this year

2020 will be the year of RELENTLESS FAVOR.

The Scriptural backdrop being taken from Jeremiah 29:11. Now even though this is a very popular scripture, it is also quoted while being robbed of its context and importance historically. Jeremiah sends this letter to exiles in Babylon sometime following the deportation from Jerusalem in 597 B.C.E. Jeremiah addresses issues faced by the exiles. His word that their stay in Babylon would be lengthy was disputed by several false prophets who were fomenting unrest among them. Jeremiah's basic response to the exiles is to settle in for the long haul, but they should know that God has not forgotten them.

The letter of Jeremiah consists of the following: the exiles are to build their homes in Babylon and to live peacefully there (29:5-7), ignore the false prophets who dream of an early restoration (29:8-9), be assured that God has their welfare in mind and that they will be returned to the land (29:10-14), and understand that judgment will fall on those who trust in the words of the false prophets (29:15-23). God's plans for the exiles are laid out clearly: "plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope" (29:11). God is present and active among them for their good.

The opening section of the letter (29:5-7) has received the most attention. Given the length of the stay (some seventy years), the exiles should build houses, plant gardens, marry and have children, and even plan for marriages of their children. The assumption is that God will be present and active in their daily lives even in this foreign land and among people they could name as their enemies. Even more, the exiles are not only to be concerned about their own life but the life of the people among whom they are living. Indeed, they are to promote the well-being of the Babylonians and even pray for them (see also Proverbs 25:21-22; Matthew 5:44)! The word commonly translated "welfare" (shalom) occurs three times (and in Jeremiah 29:11). God is concerned about the welfare of a "pagan" city, including individuals and the community as a whole. Such activities would affect their own lives in a positive way.

God was speaking to a people in lockdown, telling them to settle in and get comfortable, they would be there for a while, but his plans for them were yet on his mind and in destiny's reach. The word Relentless means something is unwavering, sure, constant, steady, and persistent. Come COVID, Financial hardship, sickness, unloving spouses, unruly children, unkind bosses, unforgiving people, and seemingly unbeatable foes, the Favor of God towards his people is yet Unrelenting.

I am not saying this fight will be easy, quick, or smooth, but if you hold onto God, and be faithful to him it will be worth it!
